conjunction and water is pumped up to the tank. However the well on that property had gone dry and so our kids since we opened back in 2010 have had to be dependent upon rain water to fill the tank and or dirty water sources boiled even for drinking water. The water issue has been a very serious situation.

One of Steve & I's spiritual daughters Isabel and her husband Dylan heard from the Lord to finance this first well. In my prayer / war room I heard the Holy Spirit decree this well would be called Sandy's Well Of Life. Sandy is Izzy's birth mothers name who is in heaven and the name of our grandchild Izzy's, little girl due to be born this October.

#### Here's a few stats of the necessity of clean water...

The need for clean water is critical and essential. Here are some stats from Africa:

- •Waterborne diseases are the second leading cause of death for children under the age of 5.
- •Nearly 700 million people lack access to safe drinking water.
- •60% of infant deaths worldwide are related to waterborne illnesses.

Each new well drilled and established on average, provide 1000 people in the villages and surrounding areas with disease-free drinking water. While the average cost of a new or restored well remains \$4800 through most ministry organizations, our cost to bring a crew in is much cheaper, \$3500 and clean water can be provided for a child or an adult — in most cases for an entire lifetime!

Clean water is a lifesaving blessing for today and a promise for a better, brighter future!



Drilling wells in Africa is costly, but crucial to wiping out leading cause of preventable blindness and assuring wiping out a multitude of diseases due to unclean water and bad sanitation with bathing and toiletries.

- Trachoma is a painful, potentially blinding eye disease that was once endemic around the globe, but as clean water and sanitation systems became widespread, it disappeared from the industrialized world.

Today it remains a problem in 55 nations where living conditions are poor and safe water and sanitation are scarce. In Kenya and Zambia, where Some organizations are drilling wells as part of its strategy to conquer trachoma, up to 30 percent of children are infected. With new wells drilled we drastically reduce the risk of a multiplicity of serious disease leading to premature death.

"Past efforts to deal with trachoma focused on treatment alone, only to find that without clean water and good sanitation the eye disease and other serious diseases would return and or remain. "Clean water and sanitation cost more up front, but long term, they are the most economical option as they permanently eradicate almost every disease."

The cost of drilling wells in Africa varies widely depending on depth of the water table, geological formations and available local resources. In Sinazongwe, Zambia, for example, the average cost of a well is between \$3,500.00 to \$5,000.00 These relatively shallow wells average 65 meters in depth, so simple hand pumps are adequate to operate them. For people in any of these drought-prone rural areas, safe accessible water is the difference between barely surviving and thriving. It's the key to good health, educational opportunities and a long life.

### **Water Situation**

In these next pictures you will see the current water situation widely used. In August when we visited the kids, I noticed the dirty water in the large round buckets (Showed in the



picture to the right) that they were bathing the younger children in.



Also right behind our facility a hole (similar to the picture above) this dirt muddy hole is where they draw water from for the older kids to take sponge baths.

### **Extraordinary People Awards**

Again this year Steve & I have been ask to return to the second annual EXTRAORDINARY PEOPLE
